What to do	You can present your work about countries in different time zones however you would like. This could be as a poster, diagram, world map, slideshow, booklet, model, or any other creative format.
Success Criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Include at least five countries from different time zones (e.g., United States, Japan, Brazil, Australia, United Kingdom).• Label or identify the time zones for each country (e.g., Eastern Standard Time for New York or Japan Standard Time for Tokyo).• Include key information about each time zone, such as how the time difference affects communication, business, or daily schedules with other countries.• Do you have family members who live in a different time zone? Include their country or city in your project. Describe how the time difference affects when you call or video chat with them.• Have you been on holiday to a country in a different time zone? Share your experience!
