

## <u>Key Vocabulary</u>

Conflict - a serious disagreement or argument, typically a long one.

Shelter - a place giving temporary protection from bad weather or danger

Deprived - suffering a severe and damaging lack of basic materials (like food)


Allied - joined by or relating to members of an alliance.

Axis - the alliance of Nazi Germany, Italy, and Japan


Rationing - allow each person to have only a fixed amount of something, like food.

Propaganda - information, especially of a biased or misleading nature, used to promote a political cause

## The Blitz

Intense bombing of busy (built-up) areas to try to cause considerable damage
